Message from Mrs Toplis, Headteacher

Although a long half term, we seem to be jogging along at a very fast pace and we are almost at the end of our first half term already.

It is lovely to see all the children settled in their classes and cracking on with the business of learning. We have our first Read Write Inc. assessments of the year next week and after that we will sort new phonics groups for the following half term. Some children will have made lots of progress and others will need a little more time to consolidate their phonic and reading skills so may not change to a new colour group. Our reception children have done fantastically well at learning their individual letter sounds and are working hard at learning to blend. Hopefully, our reception parents now know how to help at home with phonics after Mrs Gotterson's introduction workshop.

Thank you to all those reception parents who came along to both the phonics and maths workshops in the last couple of weeks. It was lovely to see so many of you and we are grateful for the support with your child's learning journey. As I said right back at induction evenings this is a two way journey together.

The weather is now very autumnal and as we use our outside areas so much, please can you make sure that your child has a pair of wellingtons in school or brings them each day if this is what you prefer. Children cannot access the grass area at playtimes and lunchtimes without wellingtons as it is so muddy and they then need to change back into their shoes when they go in, to prevent too much mud transference around the school!
