It has been a long half term but we have now reached the end and the children have been amazing. Apologies but there was a mistake in the sending of the last newsletter so well done everyone for turning up to Harvest without the full information!



It is lovely to see all the children settled in their classes and cracking on with the business of learning. We had our first Read Write Inc. assessments of the year last week and we have sorted new phonics groups for next half term. Some children have made lots of progress and others need a little more time to consolidate their phonic and reading skills so may not change to a new colour group. Our reception children have done fantastically well at learning their individual letter sounds and are working hard at learning to blend. Hopefully, our reception parents now know how to help at home with phonics after Mrs Gotterson's introduction workshop.

Thank you to all those reception parents who came along to both the phonics and Maths workshops in the last couple of weeks. It was lovely to see so many of you and we are grateful for the support with your child's learning journey. As I said right back at induction evenings this is a two way journey together.

The weather is now very autumnal and as we use our outside areas so much, please can you make sure that your child has a pair of wellingtons in school or brings them each day if this is what you prefer. Children cannot access the grass area at playtimes and lunchtimes without wellingtons as it is so muddy and they then need to change back into their shoes when they go in, to prevent too much mud transference around the school!
